Kentucky Potatoes

SEASON: Late June to October

NUTRITION FACTS: Potatoes are a good source of vitamins B and C, potassium and complex carbolydrates. They do not contain fat, cholesterol or sodium. There is only 70 calories in a ½ cup serving of cooked potato. Most nutrients are located just below the skin, so avoid peeling whenever possible.

SELECTION: Select firm potatoes free from winkles, green spots or bruises. New potatoes are immature potatoes of any variety. They are creamy, thin-skinned and small enough to serve whole. New potatoes are best in dishes that call for boiled potatoes as they will hold their shape. For baking, frying and mashing choose drier varieties such as russet or Yukon Gold.

STORAGE: Potatoes should be kept in a cool, humid, dark, well ventilated place. Do not store in

PREPARATION: Potatoes should be thoroughly washed and scrubbed before cooking. Any sprouts or eyes should be cut out. Common methods of preparation include boiling, baking, microwaving, mashing, frying and grilling.
