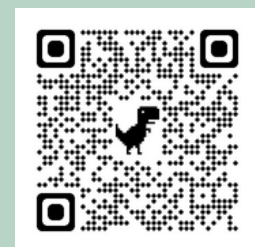

# Fort Harrod “Heritage Skills” Craft Camp

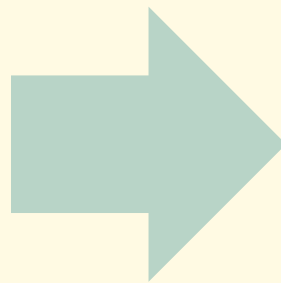
